Aim and characteristics of the eContentplus programme

Overall aim

"to make digital content in Europe more accessible, usable and exploitable, facilitating the creation and diffusion of information, in areas of public interest, at Community level".

Enabling role

Help content stakeholders (providers and users) realise the full potential of digital content

... by creating better conditions for accessing, using and exploiting digital material

... based on which it will be possible to build added-value products and services across Europe



European Network on Geographic Information Enrichment and Reuse
Network for promotion of cross border dialogue and exchange of best practices on Spatial Data Infrastructures (SDI's) throughout Europe

- Objectives of ESDI-Netplus:
 - Bring together SDI key players and target users
 - Promote high-level decisions and bottom-up discussion, and information exchange
 - Increase awareness concerning importance of GI enrichment and SDI for GI re-use
 - Foster creation of guidelines, standards and implementation of best practices
 - Establish communication mechanisms between European and local levels
 - Develop solutions for multicultural and multilingual access, exploitation and (re) use
 - Stimulate aggregation of existing national data sets into cross-border platforms
- Identification and Analysis of Best Practices (WP #2)
- Best Practices Showcase – European Award 2009 (WP #3)
- Network (WP#1), Awareness & Dissemination (WP #4) and Sustainability (WP #5)

- INSPIRE and the long term support of EUROGI to the Directive
- Fast growing of GI digital content has not been accompanied by dissemination and accessibility measures
- Need for enrichment of GI by semantically well-defined metadata and the implementation of SDI
- Platform for communication and exchange between stakeholders
- Functions of a SDI
 - Data
 - Services and Platform
 - Networking people and organisations
- Sustainability of a SDI
 - Requirements: Strategic, Performance
 - Sustainability: Financial, Political, Human resources
- Users of SDI
Government agencies, Private Sector, Citizens

- Identify and analyse SDI through interviews followed by workshops
- Mostly targeting sub national SDI across Europe
NUTS 1, NUTS 2 and NUTS 3 (EUROSTAT), flexibility
- Urbanisation of SDI – side product
How the sub-national SDIs cooperate among each other and with the national level?
- Seven categories of assessment:
 - **Sub-national SDI identity card:** Basic identification data
 - **SDI usage assessment:** Integration, Objectives, Stakeholders, Social impacts
 - **Networking people assessment:** Humanware, Mechanisms, Raising awareness
 - **Socio-economic impact analysis:** Results, Indirect assessment, Indicators
 - **Organisational assessment:** interface with governance, Funding & team, Other
 - **Coping with legal aspects:** Sustainability, Framework, Legal Compliance, Legal status
 - **Technical functionalities-facilities-components:** Data, Services, Technical context
- **Framework and Common parameters - SDI European Award 2009**

General objective:
